

This text is above all a code of good conduct. Its purpose is to clarify the responsibility of users, in accordance with the legislation, in order to establish a correct use of the computer resources and Internet services of Club Ecoclope, with courtesy and respect for others.

1. Définitions

«Internet services» will denote the provision by remote servers of various means of exchange and information: web, messaging, forum, etc. The term “user” will denote the person having access to or using the Internet services..

2. Access to club internet services

Use of Club Ecoclope’s shared internet services is subject to authorization via a secure connection. This authorization is strictly personal and cannot under any circumstances be transferred, even temporarily, to a third party. This authorization can be withdrawn at any time. It ends upon termination of membership of the Ecoclope Club.

3. Rules of use, safety and good practice

All users are responsible for using the internet services to which they have access.

The use of these internet services must be rational and fair in order to avoid their saturation or their diversion for personal gain.

In particular :

- he must report any attempted violation of his account and, in general, any anomaly that he may notice;
- he chooses passwords that are secure, kept secret and in no case must communicate them to third parties;
- he undertakes not to provide unauthorized users with access to systems or networks, through equipment of which he is in use;
- he must not use or attempt to use accounts other than his own or hide his real identity;
- he must not attempt to read, modify, copy or destroy data other than those which belong to him directly or indirectly; in particular, he must not modify the file (s) containing accounting or identification information

4. Privacy conditions

Access by users to information and documents stored on computer systems should be limited to those specific to them, and to those that are public or shared. In particular, it is forbidden to take cognizance of information held by other users, even if they have not explicitly protected it. This rule also applies to private conversations of the email type to which the user is neither directly nor in copy.

5. Preservation of the integrity of IT systems

The user agrees not to deliberately disrupt the proper functioning of Internet services, whether by abnormal handling or by the introduction of parasitic software known under the generic name of viruses, Trojans, logic bombs...

6. Use of internet services (web, forum...)

The user must make use of the club’s internet services within the exclusive framework of club activities and in compliance with the legislation in force.

In particular :

- he must not engage in actions knowingly endangering the security or the proper functioning of the servers he accesses;
- he must not impersonate another person and he must not intercept communications between third parties;
- he must not use these services to offer or make accessible to third parties data and information that is confidential or contrary to the legislation in force;
- he must show the utmost correctness towards his interlocutors in electronic exchanges by mail, discussion forums, etc.;
- he must ensure compliance with the laws, in particular those relating to offensive, racist, pornographic and defamatory publications.

The Ecoclope Club cannot be held responsible for any deterioration of information or offenses committed by a user who does not comply with these rules.

7. Analysis and control of resource use

For maintenance and technical management requirements, the use of Internet services as well as exchanges via the network can be analyzed and controlled in compliance with applicable legislation and in particular the law on data processing and freedoms.

8. Reminder of the main French laws

It is recalled that anyone on French soil must comply with French legislation, in particular in the field of computer security, in particular:
